


ACCESSING DAYMAP FROM HOME

Parents and caregivers

The parent portal provides parents and caregivers with access to homework and attendance information.

Before accessing the portal for the first time, it is essential you use the email address you provided to the school at the time of enrolment. If you haven't already provided the school with this information, please call the school on 8258 5466 (note: it may take up to 24hrs after entering your email address for Daymap to process the data and allow you to access the portal).


3. Click on the **<Parent Portal>** link under the heading *Daymap*.


The Parent Portal provides parents/caregivers access to homework and attendance information for students under their care.

1. If you have used the portal before, you can log in using your existing Username (email address provided to the school) and Password. If this is the first time you have logged into the portal, click **<New User>**



- Enter the email address you have shared with the school, your student's ID number (this is the 6-digit number shown on their Student ID Card) then click the **<Reset Password>** button.




Enter the email address you have registered with the school along with a matching valid student code. A link to set your password will be emailed to you.



You should now have access to the parent portal. The first screen shows attendance and current homework. A **blue tick** shows the student was present at a lesson, and a **blue cross** that they were absent for a known reason. A **red cross** shows they were absent from a lesson they were meant to attend.

Homework set by the staff is shown below the week's timetable.

Clicking on the **<Attendance Tab>** will provide you with a record of the student's attendance throughout the year.



Students

1. Go to the school's website at www.phhs.sa.edu.au and click on the **<Student Resources>** button on the top right of the screen (under *Students* menu).



2. Click on the **<Student portal login>** link on the page under the Daymap heading.
